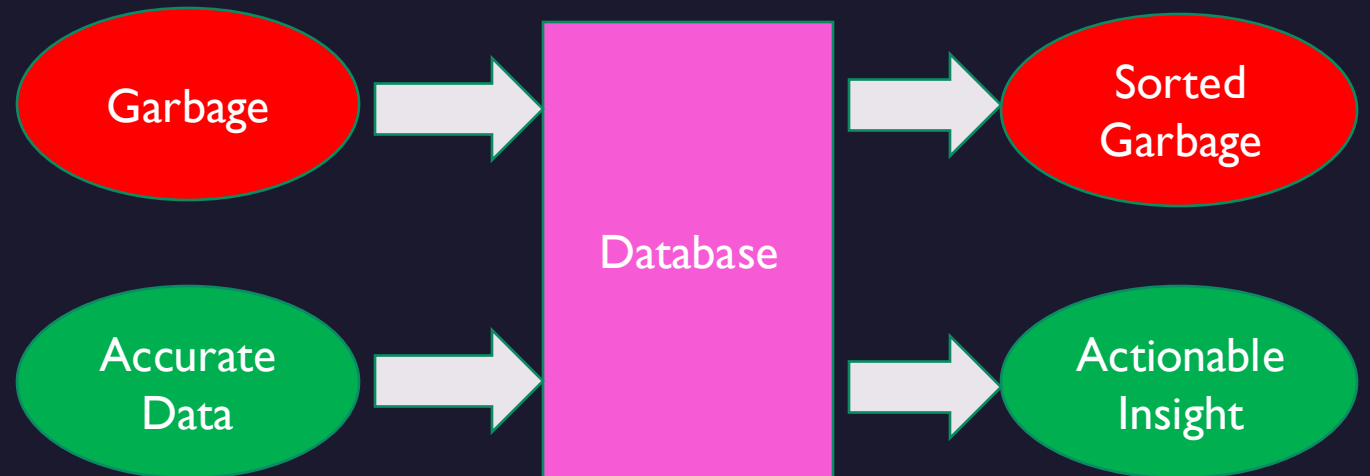


Data Quality

- Accuracy - data is entered accurately
- Consistency – data is consistent , no contradictions of data

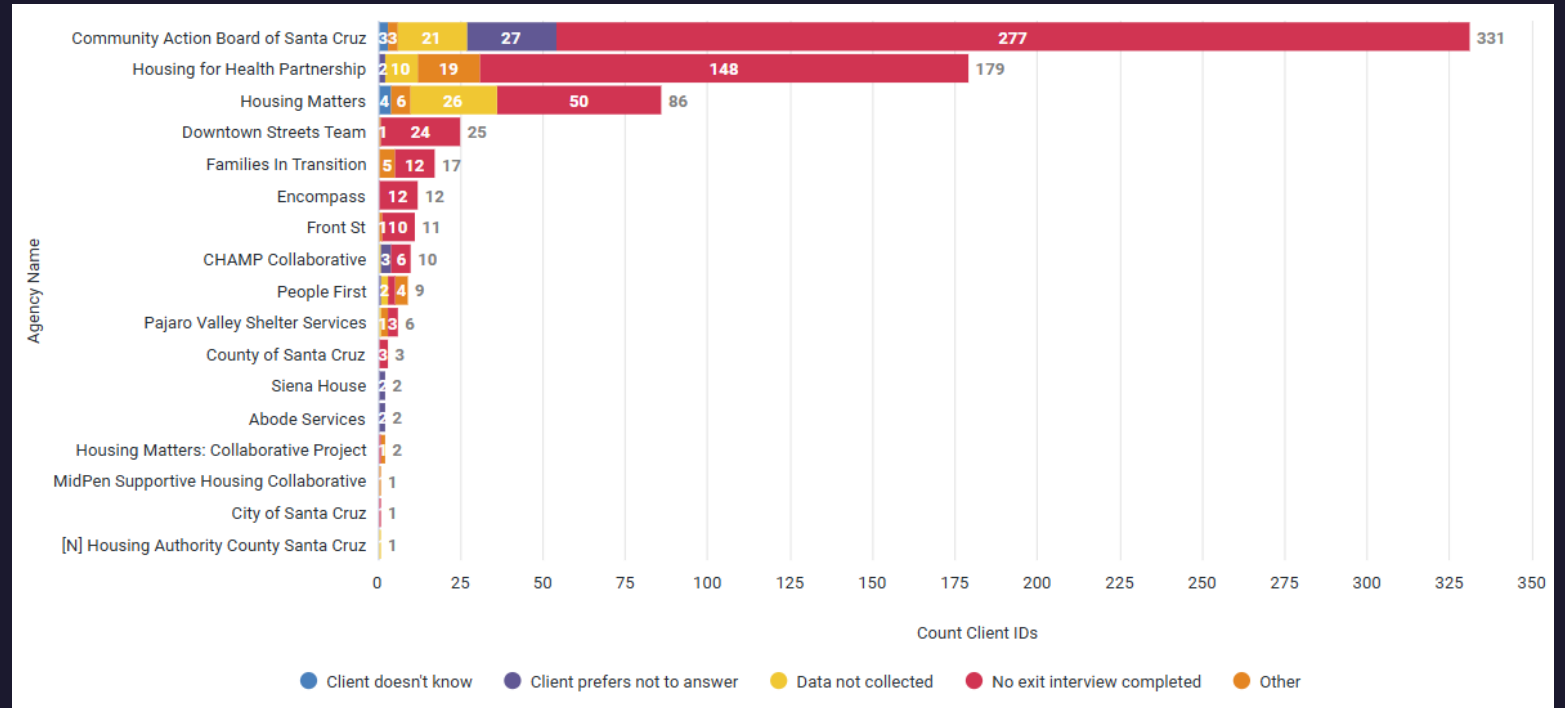
