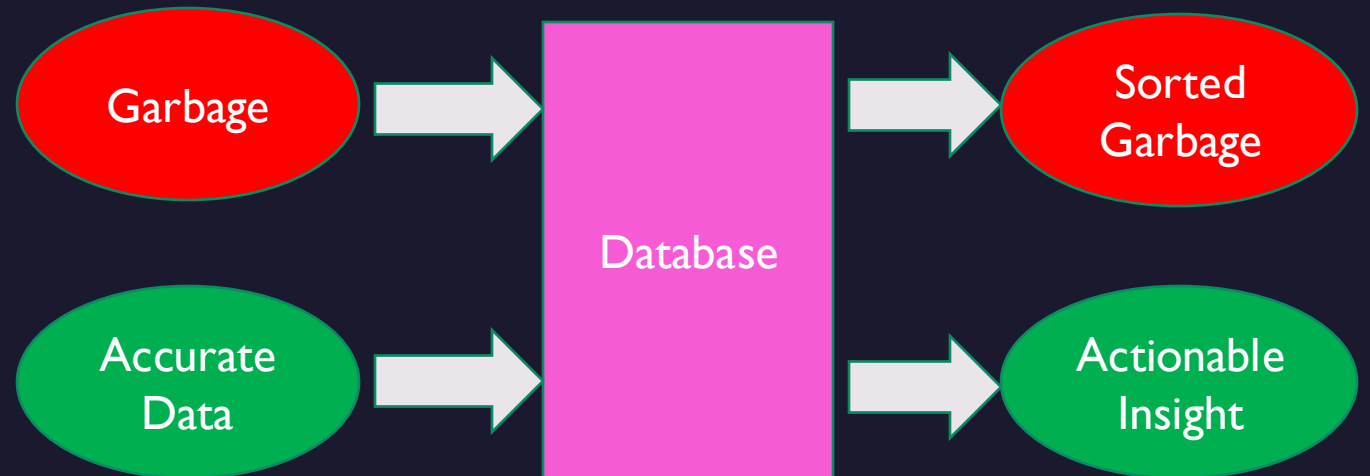


Data Quality

- Consistency – data is consistent , no contradictions of data

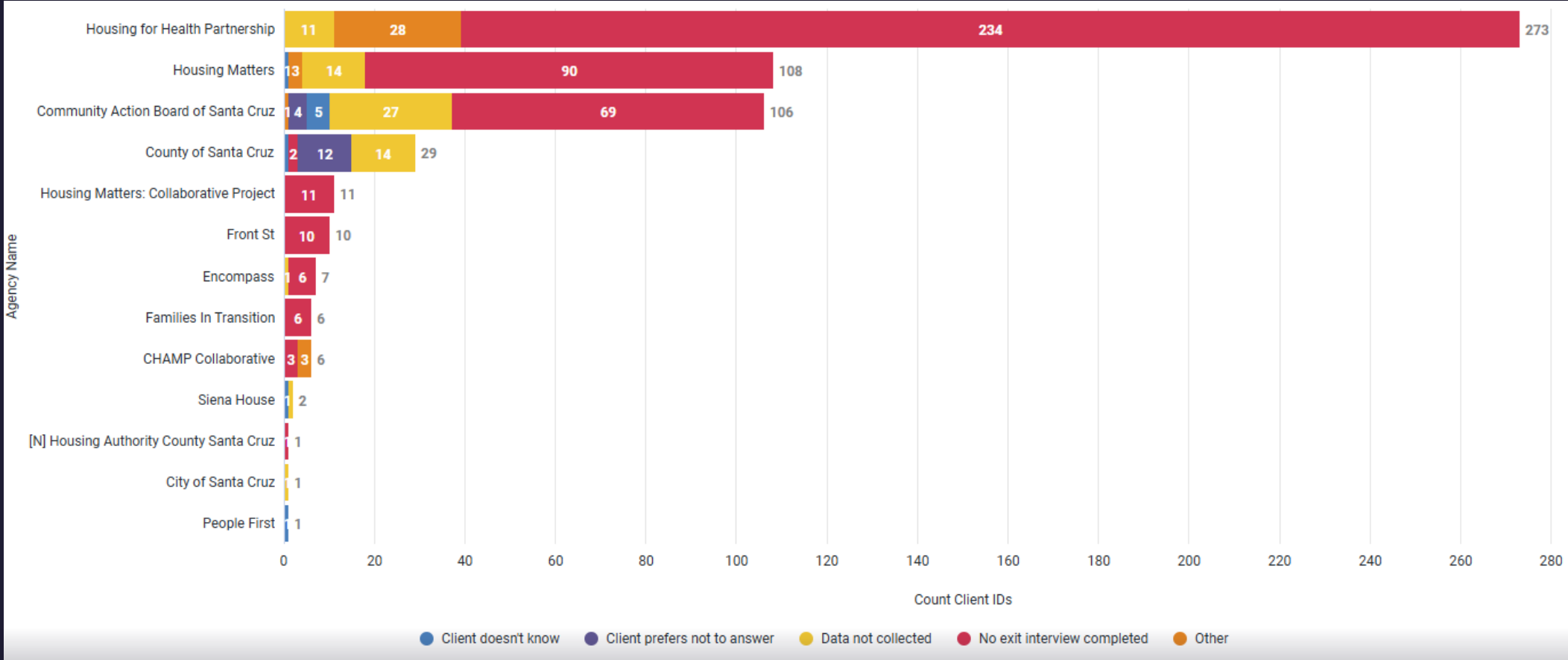
